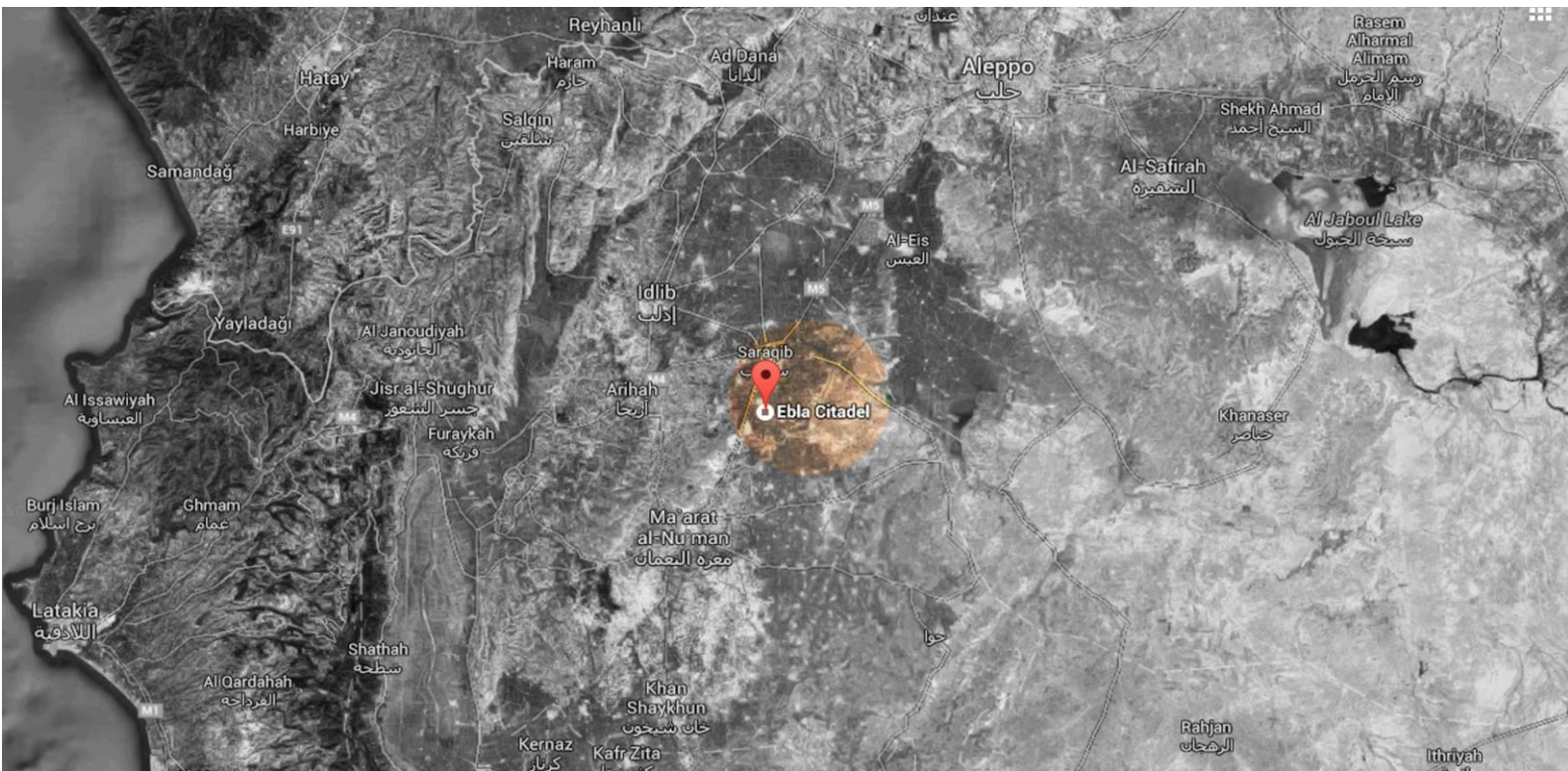

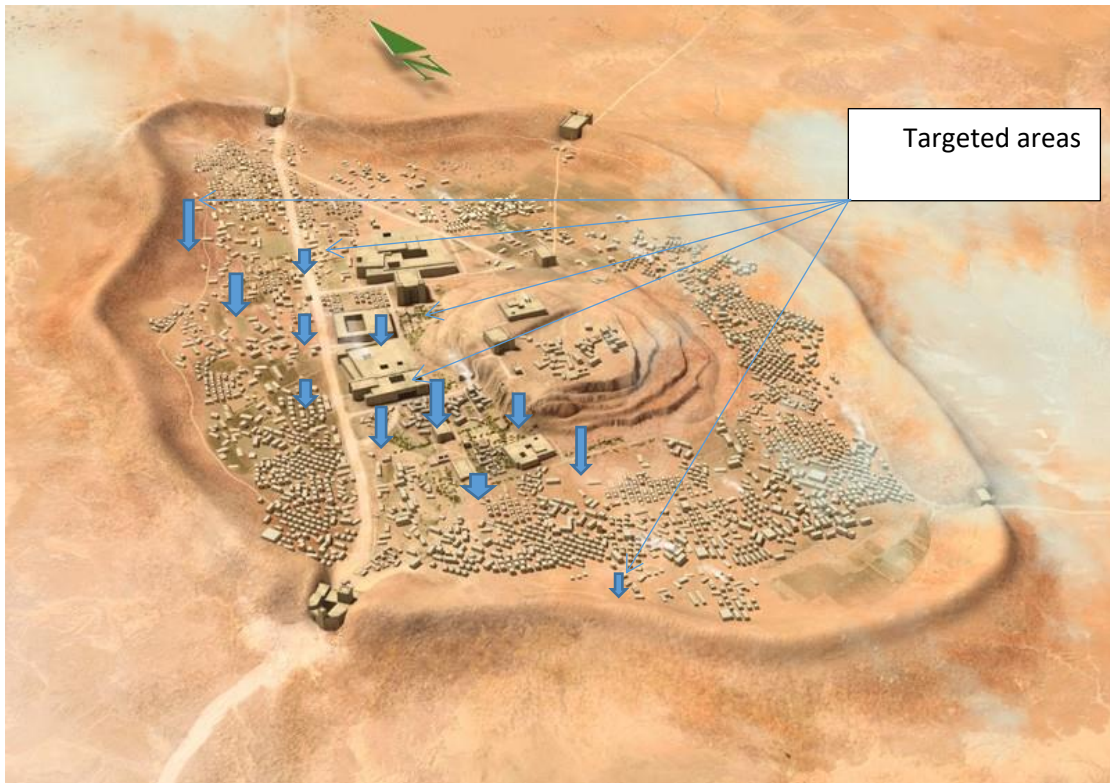

23rd & 24th of September, 2017



On the 23rd and 24th of September 2017, the Russian air force carried 23 air strikes on the archaeological site of Ebla inflicting heavy damage. The damage was documented by the joint TDA/Syrian Heritage Center site monitors.

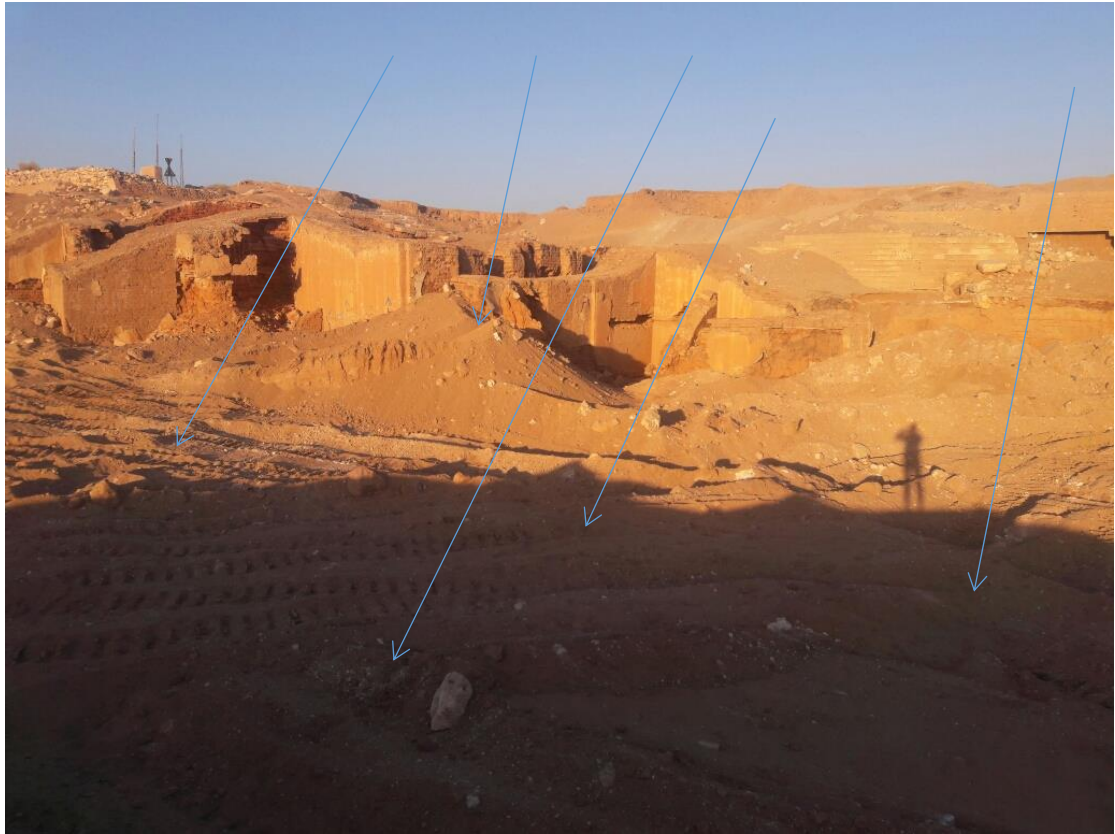
